

Does your child have attention problems?

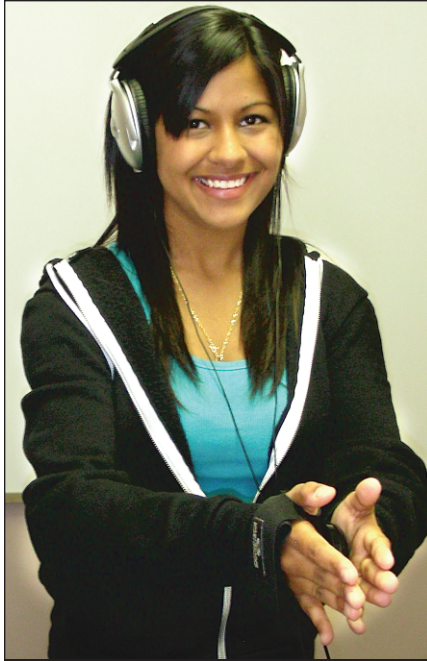
Interactive Metronome(IM), offered by Strategic Learning Centre, may be the answer.
